ENTRY CLOSING DEADLINES 2021

All goat consigned entries May 15
Clinics May 15
Late entry June 1
Substitutes June 1

1.Competition is open to the world in all classes. Exhibitors are responsible for knowing and complying with all rules and regulations contained herein:

2.Application for SALE entry: All entries must be submitted through the form on the website midwestbucksale.com. Each consignor or participant may print the entry information obtained from the Midwest Buck Sale. The application shall be signed by the exhibitor/owner, or by entering online and paying fees, confirms an agreement with the Midwest Buck Sale, LLC to have an evaluation and then offer for sale, to the highest bidder, at the event from June 6, 2021.

Entries to the Boer Goat Congress and other coloured congresses is online through the website.

Application for entry may be printed and mailed to P.O. Box 331, Vinita, OK 74301.

ENTRY RULES:

Private treaty sales are strictly forbidden on the grounds at the time of the events June 2-6, 2021. Selling of stock at the pens or on the grounds during any day of the event, is not allowed. Those that sell privately will be asked to leave. The Midwest Buck Sale, LLC takes great time and effort to create an atmosphere where breeders & sellers may sell safely and buyers may buy with confidence, through the sale. Please respect our event. If selling, enter your stock in the Sale June 6, 2021.

The transportation of outside stock is allowed through the Missouri State Fairgrounds, please contact their office directly, to rent available stalls in other barns.

Stock not entered into a show, evaluation, buck alley, clinic, demonstration, or the MBS may not be stalled under the swine pavilion.

Emails, telephone calls, or facsimiles will not be accepted for the purpose of entry, substitutions, or cancelation. Online, through the Midwestbucksale.com website is the method of entry. Payment may be made by printing and mailing payment.

3.Entry Deadline: Entries postmarked by midnight of the above dates will be accepted. Late fees will be assessed for late entries.

4.EXHIBITORS and SELLERS are encouraged to make their ENTRIES AS EARLY AS POSSIBLE.

Catalog and stalling charts must be created, early entries are appreciated.

5.Fees:

- Entry: \$15.00
- Commission: 7% PO Fee 7%
- Pens: \$5.00 Additional
- Tack pen: \$5.00
- Shavings \$7.00 bag

6. Specific stalling requests must be made at time of entry.

7. Return check fee: \$30.00

8. Awards and prizes for Grand and Reserve. (In the future, when premiums are paid, the winners must provide completed tax forms and return them to the Midwest Buck Sale, LLC. This applies to cash prizes awarded by the MBS only.)

9. Each sale entry will be assigned a number in the official catalog for the sale. If you decide to sell your stock in the Midwest Buck Sale, June 6, the exhibitor/owner will receive a entry number that corresponds with the catalog number of the animal in the sale. These cards must be displayed while stock is penned and being judged.

10. Substitutions: Substitutions are accepted up and until midnight, May June 1, 2021, with the proper fees paid. This is for single entries only. Group classes may not be substituted.

11. Cancellations: Cancellations are accepted and should be sent in writing. **There are no refunds.** Once entry fees are paid, they become the property of the Midwest Buck Sale, LLC and in no part, portion, and no exceptions, **there will be no refunds**, unless changes are made within the event.

12. Please use parking hangers if they are provided.

13. No motorized vehicles inside the pavilion, unless authorized by the show management.

14. Designated trailer parking area will be provided.

15. Designated Exhibitor parking area will be provided.

16. Missouri State Fairgrounds provides a camping area. This is first come, first served, and payment goes directly to the MSFG.

EXHIBITION RULES

All entries must accompany fees to be completed.

17. Interpretation and violation of rules: The Midwest Buck Sale, LLC reserves the final and absolute right to interpret these rules and regulations and to arbitrarily settle and determine all matters, questions, and differences, in regards thereto or otherwise resulting out of, or connected with, or incident to, the event, and the right to amend, or add to these rules as it

judges and deems necessary. The exhibitor/owner that violates any of the rules, will forfeit prizes and awards given by the Midwest Buck Sale, LLC.

18.Special Rules: Special rules and conditions are published in each breed category where necessary. If there is a conflict between the special rules of any breed and the general rules and regulations, the special rules may govern. Contact Midwestbucksale@gmail.com for any questions.

19.Liability: Each exhibitor, owner, consigner, or other individual or entity, participating in any aspect of the Midwest Buck Sale, including without limitation, livestock entrants and individuals, including any of their heirs, dependents, assigns, agents, or representatives in any capacity, hereby waves all rights and claims for damages, and do hereby agree to release, hold harmless, and unconditionally indemnify the Midwest Buck Sale, LLC, Midwest Buck Sale and Shows, co-producers, sponsors, any officials, employees, volunteers, and others involved, thereof, from and against all liability cost, expenses, claims of damages, even if caused by the alleged negligence or gross negligence of the Midwest Buck Sale, LLC shows and sale, which the event and livestock show participant, may at any time suffer or sustain, or become liable for, by reason of any accidents, damages, injuries, or incidents, either to the person or property, or both, or the Midwest Buck Sale, or a Midwest Buck Sale participant.

20.Protests: Each protest must be in writing, within 2 hours of the end of the announcement of award, along with a \$500.00 nonrefundable donation to the MWBS scholarship foundation. Such protest must plainly state the cause of the complaint or appeal. The Midwest BuckSale management will make all final decisions on all matters.

21.Objectionable exhibits: The Midwest Buck Sale management reserves the right to remove any objectionable display, exhibit, animal, person(s), or entity, without assigning a reason, if it is falsely entered or objectionable or unsuitable in any way. No refunds shall be given.

22.Conflicts: Nothing shall be sold, given away, or otherwise dispose of by exhibitors which will in any way conflict with, or which is subject matter of, any privilege or concession granted or sold by the Midwest Buck Sale, LLC.

23.No person shall be permitted to distribute advertising matter upon the grounds, except from his place of business (vendor) or exhibitor space. The tacking or posting of any advertisement, bill's etc, other than within the space occupied by the exhibits, will be strictly prohibited. The distribution of handbills, flyers, and heralds will under no circumstances be permitted. Begging, soliciting, singing, or public speaking, other than events that are scheduled, is prohibited.

24.Cooking: Cooking is prohibited other than concession stand and vendors **with permission**. No cookers, crock pots, microwaves, coffee pots, warmers, or any other cooking utensils are permitted.

25.Registration: Registered animals must accompany their original registration certificate. All certificates must be surrendered at the time of check in. Stock does not have to be registered to be evaluated or sell.

26.Health certificates: All health certificates must accompany all livestock at check in, and all paperwork must be checked prior to being unloaded.

27.Scrapie tag: All stock must have a USDA permanent scrapie tag in the ear of the animal entered and listed on the health certificate. Tattoos must be legible and microchipped stock must be accompanied by a reader.

28.DNA: All DNA information must be provided at the time of check in, if available. DNA is not required to sell or for stock to be evaluated.

29.Ownership: All stock must be entered by the owner of record.

30.Showman: Anyone may show stock that is entered.

31.Firms and Partnerships: Firms and Partnerships entering animals' doe competition, must be in existence prior to entry and must be bona fide. A firm or partnership may be an exhibitor.

32.Breeder defined: Breeder is the owner of the dam at the time of conception.

33. Midwest Buck Sale is not the "seller" of stock, but the provider of the platform for professionals to share genetics and information.

34. Each breeder is the responsible party if selling stock and represents them in an honest fashion. Required testing and paperwork must be in order. Questions about stock are to be addressed to the consignor.
