Departure: Friday before 10 pm

Stalls must be cleaned before departing.

You may show from your trailer.

Pen Fee \$8.00

Shavings for bedding (do not use hay or straw for bedding)

Weight Cards Due 1 pm with a 5-pound weigh back for top three placings.

Three Divisions: Light Weight, Medium Weight, and Heavy Weight

Classes will be divided as closely as possible, and as evenly as possible, within 10 pound weight range (maximum)

Minimum weight 40 pounds, max weight 135.

No tooth rule.

No ownership Rules.

1. All animals must be inspected prior to unloading.
2. Market goat wethers must be clipped with hair no longer than 1/4 inch above the knees & hocks.
3. Market/Breeding Does are clipped at the preference of the showman.
4. All animals must have a scrapie tag, tattooed with a registration certificate, microchipped or other means of permanent identification and be listed on a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection. If the animal has a microchip as its permanent identification, the exhibitor is responsible for providing a microchip reader. Tattoos or other means of permanent identification will be checked with the registration papers at the time of check-in.
5. Grooming is at the desire of the exhibitor. Please be responsible.
6. No **permanent** physical changes may be made to the animals.
7. The animal's hair color may not be changed, artificially, into another color.
8. Please bring your stock washed & clipped prior to the event.
9. Any goat showing any pronounced defect or abnormality, such as a weak constitution, unthrifty condition, overshot jaw or undershot jaw, or abscesses, will be barred from showing in any of the Market or Breeding classes.
10. All goats must be free of clinical signs of an infectious or contagious disease.
11. No drenching.
12. No show halter leads with any sharp objects and/or cable halters (including cable leads) will be allowed.
13. Minimum weight 40 lbs.
14. Max weight 135
15. No tooth rule.
16. Horns are allowed.
17. Style of showing is up to the exhibitor.

18. Bracing is allowed in both Wether and Doe Shows.
19. Each exhibitor may enter a maximum of three does and three wethers. A total of six head, in the Market shows
20. Another youth must show if multiple animals in one class.
21. No ownership rules.

### **CLASSES: Market Wethers and Market/Breeding Does**

Show separately. ABGA Registered Does may not show in the JABGA show if they are shown in the Anything Does Show. They may only show in one or the other.

1. Three Divisions:
  - a. Light weight
  - b. Medium Weight
  - c. Heavy Weight

2. Depending on entries, classes will be as close to ten head per class and within a ten-pound range.
3. Proper show attire
